

Official CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

Meeting of October 6, 1931.

SUMMARY

Police protection at Walter's school asked. School Board wants improvement deferred. Complete report on water suit, fees, given. Hollywood Riviera planting to be told council. Improvement Asked

Clerk Bartlett read Resolution from the Torrance Chamber of Commerce, under date of October 6, 1931, requesting the City Council of Torrance to take immediate preliminary steps to present to the property owners, in the so-called Vista Highlands District, the approximate cost of such proposed improvements, which the territory is lacking.

Transfer Inspections

Councilman Nelson called attention to the weeds growing on the vacant clear store at corner of Cabrillo and Gramercy, Clerk Bartlett stated this store was to be taken care of this week.

Report On Oil Derrick

City Attorney Findley reported regarding suit on validity of Water Bonds that plaintiff had filed brief on the demurrer supposed to be argued on September 15, 1931, and our attorneys will file answer in next ten days.

Attorneys' Fee Recorded

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from the Board of Education dated September 15th, 1931, addressed to E. Leonard City Engineer, regarding the proposed construction of sanitary sewers, street paving, sidewalks and curbs, affecting the Fern Avenue School site, stating that these improvements would be deferred pending Torrance Charter Election. No action was taken in this matter.

Charter Period Extended

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from the Clifford P. Reid, Inc., under date of September 22, 1931, requesting an extension of the charter period for the proposed improvements.
