County Holds Seventh Place In Industry

Los Angeles Area Containt 123 Groups of Diversified Manufacturing

Figures released through the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce by the Bureau of the Census, U. S. Department of Commerce, classify in detail the manufacturing activities of the major industrial areas in California. The classification covers the last official census taken in 1980.

The Los Angeles area, consisting of Los Angeles County—seventh largest, industrially in the country—was reported to have 4,908 manufacturing establishments, employing 14,546 wage carners receiving wages of 8,175,212,298 in addition to salarled, officers and employees numbering 31,267 with salarles of 110,712,861, or grand totals of 145,847 persons engaged by manufactured industry, receiving wages and salarles of 3285,524,859.

The total value of manufactured products of these establishments was 11,812,836,458. The cost of materials, containers for products, the laid purchased clectric energy used by these manufacturers was 11,1812,816,115. leaving the value added by the manufacturers was 11,1812, leaving the value and employees.
