 6. Sponsorship of equipment and uniforms for outfitting local American Legion Drum Corps. Result has been, stimulated local interest in this activity and a generous measure of favorable publicity through appearance of the Drum Corps. Province of the Committee and resultant adoption of program by Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce for comprehensive survey of this entire district.
