

Employment for thousands of non-compensated World war veterans is being provided through the making of red paper poppies for the Legion Auxillary's memorial poppy sate, held in May.

The poppy work is now going forward in 52 government hospitals and sonvalescent workrooms maintained by the auxiliary in 33 states. Hundreds of thousands of the little red paper flowers have atready been completed and more than ten million are expected to be made before the work closes.

Poppies for the local sale are being made at Sawtelle and San Fernando hospitals. Veterans are paid three cents for each poppy they make. Auxillary and Junior Auxillary members of Torrance unit will sell poppies here on May 27th.




