In Land Cases Set For Nov. 14

Technical objections, regarded as of a trivial nature, were under submission today by federal court to the indictment charging four persons with using the mails in a plot to fleece homesteaders on old Mexican-Spanish land grants in the San Fernando and Pales Verdes Ranchos.

The objections, interposed as a demurrer by attorneys for Williamson S. Summers, H. Newkirk Wheeler, Harry C. White and Othie A. Adams, who are named in the indictment, were argued before United States District Yudge George Congrove and taken under advisement.

Trial of the mail fraud case has been set for November 14, and numerous landowners in the Ex-Mission San Fernando, Rancho Palos Verdes and Rancho Lomas de Santiago are interested in the outcome. One of the principal objections made during Tussday's arguments before Judge Congrove was that the indictment did not set up that the land grants are located in the southern district of the federal division.

The four men under indictment are believed to have collected nearly \$1,000,000 in ao-called "attorneys" fees" for locating would be homesteaders on old Mexican-Spanish land grants. Clyde Thomas, assistant. United States district attorney who is prosecuting the case, stated he regarded in the four indictments a year ago.
