Keeping Up With | Simple Design To Be Used In Remodeling of School Buildings

Use of all available funds, approximately \$10,800,000, to give added strength and safety to more than 200 of the 2500 school buildings in the Los Angeles district will be planned this week by the board of education, according to official announcement yesterday by Supt. Frank A. Bouelle. To make this money cover assemany structures as possible, while complying with new state and city-county building codes, the board has decreed that simple architectural lines shall be followed, omitting decomitions, panining, plastering and trim wherever possible. Gymnaciuns, cafeterias, auditoriums and all other buildings not an integral part of class room work, will not be rebuilt or used

The new policy of the board outlined by resolution, follows:
