Torrance Neon Sign May Have to Be Removed

Removal of the Neon sign over Main street at Carson street, directing traffic to Torrance, may be necessitated in view of a recommendation made to the board of supervisors Monday by the county counsel, Everett W. Mattoon, author of the Mattoon Act.

"No person shall erect or maintain any sign in or on any public highway in Los Angeles county," the county counsel said in quoting the law to the supervisors, whose permission was sought recently by the Torrance city engineer to place a light pole and anchor at the corner of the intersection to support the sign.
