ORDINANCE CREATING POSITIONS OF CALL FIREMEN, PART-TIME FIREMEN AND PART-TIME PATROLMEN AND AUTHORIZING THEIR EMPLOYMENT.

The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That the public peace, health and safety requires the immediate passage and adoption of this ordinance, an initiative ordinance No. 319 having been heretofore adopted and effective

SECTION 2. That there are hereby created the positions of Call Firemen, Part-Time Firemen and Part-Time Patrolmen, the Chief of the Fire Department being hereby authorized and directed, with the ratification and approval of the City Council, to employ and fix the salaries of such Call Firemen and Part-Time Firemen as may be necessary to carry on the functions of the Fire Department of the City of Torrance, and the Chief of the Police Department being hereby authorized and directed, with the ratification and approval of the City Council, to employ and fix the salaries of such Part-Time Patrolmen as may be necessary to carry on the functions of the Police Department of the City of Torrance.

SECTION 3. The facts constituting the urgency of the immediate passage and adoption of this ordinance are as follows:

Said Ordinance No. 249 authorizes the placing of all full-paid, full-time employees of the Fire Department and Police Department under the Civil Service, and makes no provision for the employment of part-time employees, and neither department can operate efficiently without Call Firemen, Part-Time Firemen and/or Part-Time Patrolmen, and unless the employment of such persons is authorized, fires and crime in the City of Torrance can not be controlled.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance by said City Council, and shall cause the same to be published in the weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance, and thereupon and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect.
