ORDINANCE NO. 255

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BUSINESS OF SECOND-HAND DEALERS, SECOND-HAND AUTO-PARTS DEALERS, JUNK DEALERS AND JUNK COLLECTORS.
The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:
Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to engage in, conduct, manage or carry on the business of second-hand dealer, second-hand auto-parts dealer, junk dealer, or junk collector, without first having procured a license so to do and having paid the fee for such license as in this ordinance provided.

Section 7

Any person, firm, or corporation desiring to obtain a license to conduct or carry on or continue any business mentioned or defined in the next preceding section of this ordinance, shall file an application, in writing, therefor with the City Council, and shall file a duplicate copy of such application in the office of the Chief of Police of said City, specifying by street and number the place where such business is proposed to be conducted or carried on, or, in the case of a junk collector who has no fixed place of business, then such application shall specify street and number and town or city of his residence. Said application shall be signed by the applicant and shall contain the address of such applicant. If the applicant is a firm, the applicant shall state the resident addresses of the members of such firm. If the applicant is a corporation, the application shall state the resident addresses of the President and Secretary and the managing agent, if any, of such corporation.
Section 8. No license to conduct or carry on any business mentioned in this ordinance shall be granted or issued except upon order of the City Council.

Every second-hand dealer, second-hand auto-parts dealer, junk dealer and/or junk collector shall keep a complete record of all goods, wares, auto-parts, merchandise, or things received, pledged, or purchased by him, or sold or otherwise disposed of, which

Section 17

The provisions contained in Sections 12 and 16 of this ordinance shall not be deemed to apply to the purchase or sale of junk dealers or junk collectors of rags, bottles, other than milk or cream bottles, second-hand sacks, other than cement sacks, barrels, cans, shoes, lamps, stoves or household furniture (with the exception of sewing machines and musical instruments) or the purchase or sale by second-hand dealers of household furniture, with the exception of sewing machines, musical instruments, typewriters, washing machines, electrical appliances that carry serial numbers, electric drills, motors of every description, electric irons, guns, bicycles, and vacuum sweepers.

If any person, firm or corporation shall engage in, conduct, manage or carry on, at the same time, more than one of the businesses defined and referred to in this ordinance, such
