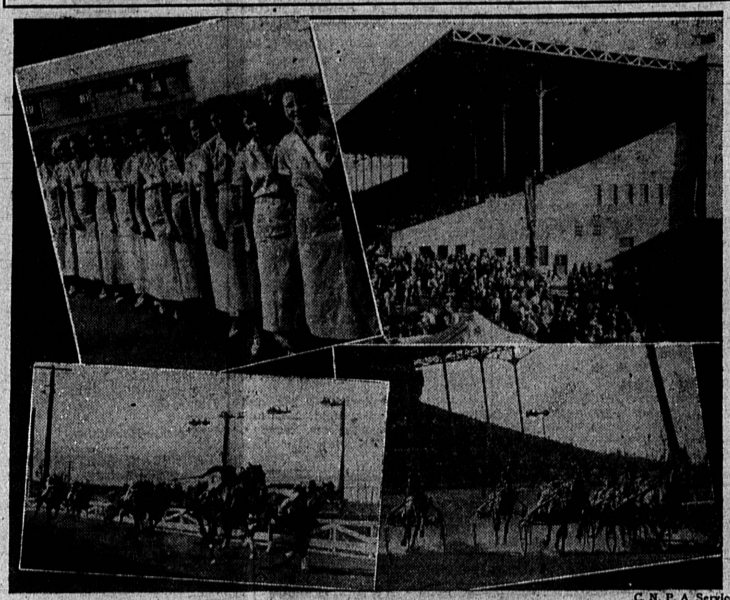

PARIS (U.P.)—France has decided to spend two million dollars during the next few years to beautify her national grounds and restore her historical structures to their pristine glory. A sum of 4,500,000 francs is to be spent alone on transforming sculptor Bourdelle's studio into a museum.

The two scholarships will be presented to Jang and Schmidt at the State Fair in Sacramento in the first week in September, by A. P. Giannini, founder of Bank of America and of the Giannini Foundation at the University of California. In all, Bank of America is making 414 awards in its survey of youthful thought. Essayists whose efforts won the commendation of the judges received a total of \$10,000 in scholarships and awards.
