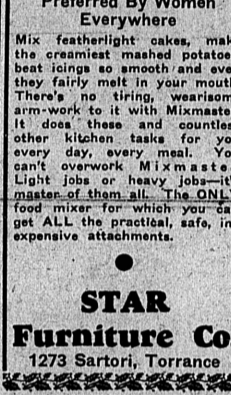

"This move was introduced by Hell with the idea of strengthening White's center and counteracting the hostile pressure on the QB file. The move is 'lowered' from the Dragon variation of the fianchetto defense in this opening."

"This is too slow. Preferable would be 6... B-N5; 7. B-Q3, N-B3; etc. 7. P-QR3"

"A considerable improvement on 7. B-K2, B-N5; 8. P-B3, castles; 9. castles, P-Q4; 10. BPXP, BxN; 11. BxP, PXP; 12. B-KN5, QN-Q2; and White will have difficulty with his QBP—(Spielman-Tartakower, Vienna, 1923)

"This enables White to protect his N at KB5 which is fatal for Black as he cannot protect himself on both wings at the same time."

"After... P-QN4 Black would be rid of the weakness of the QNP, but the new weakness on his black squares would be even more troublesome."

"He cannot help ceding control of the file; if instead 22... P-QN4; 23. B-B5, R-K; 24. N-Q6 wins."

"The game could be prolonged somewhat by 26... NxB; 27. QxP, Q-Q7; 27. Q-K3, QxQh; 29. RxQ, P-N3"

"This leads to some pretty play. For example 27... Q-N4; 28. P-KR4, Q-R4; 29. P-N4 winning the Queen. But the abandonment of the diagonal is equally ruinous."

"The courage of despair. 28... K-R would not do because of 29. Q-R6, R-K; 30. R-K2, Haas Black played 27... Q-N, the conclusion would have been 28. Q-Q2, K-R; 29. Q-R6, R-N; 30. N-Q6. 29. Q-R6 QxRch 30. B-B R-K

"Courteously allowing himself to be checkmated. 31. Q-N7 mate."

"Relief Ticket" Customers Shown Utmost Courtesy

Safeway Stores Issue Special Instructions For Serving "Relief" Orders

"Help them keep up their courage!" With this plea for the unemployed, Safeway Stores went on record today in favor of a definite policy of encouragement on the part of business toward persons who have been obliged to seek relief.

All employees of the company have been advised of a "courtesy code" which is on operative. It calls for:

1. Customers with "relief tickets" are to receive the same prompt attention and service as regular cash customers.

2. Relief tickets received from customers should be handled as inconspicuously as possible, to prevent embarrassment of the holders.

3. Relief customers are to be treated with all due respect and courtesy.

Encouragement of this sort, however, is only a part of Safeway's plan to help the unemployed. The company has a rule to handle only first-quality merchandise, of which ticket holders have free choice of any items specified by their relief agencies.

In addition, the company is now selling its milk and similar family necessities to relief agencies at a price considerably below the cost of production, according to officials.
