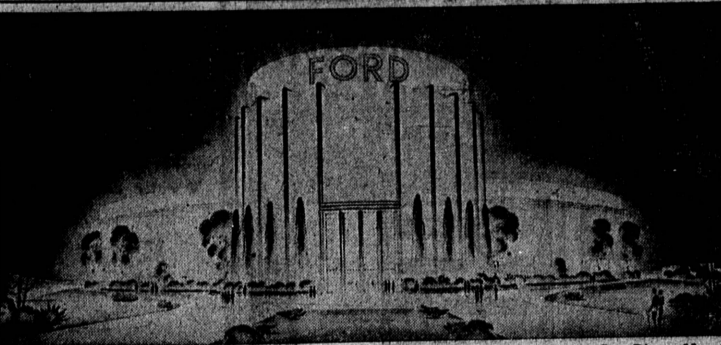

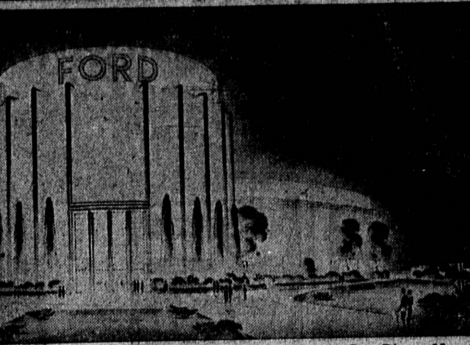

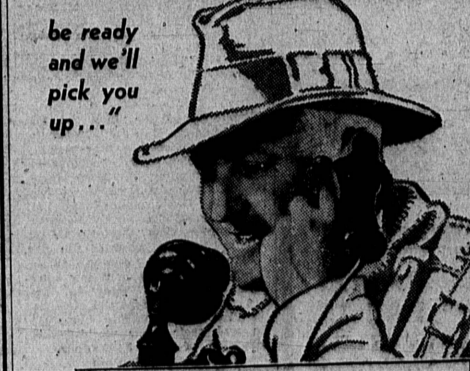

News From Washington By Your Congressman CHARLES J. COLDEN

The banking bill has occupied the attention of the House for the past week. It is a revision of the present banking laws and among other things is making the insurance of bank deposits a permanent feature of our banking system.

Another provision of this bill which strengthens the government control of banks and credit of the country has aroused considerable controversy. It revives the old age struggle as between the government on one side and the bankers on the other.

It was brought out in this discussion that it was President Wilson's idea in the establishment of the federal reserve system to place it under the control of a board in Washington made up of men whose experience in the money and credit business lines of the country.

The United States Chamber of Commerce has been holding a convention in Washington and started quite a hullabaloo in the politics of the capital city. The United States Chamber of Commerce dipped deeply into politics, gave the Roosevelt New Deal quite a drubbing and incidentally gave the Republican party quite a boost.

The result of this political assault on President Roosevelt and the New Deal has created quite a furore and stirred up a political duststorm in Washington. The attitude of the United States Chamber of Commerce indicates that the organized business interests of this country are fighting the New Deal tooth and toe and discloses some of the powerful reactionary influences that the President must combat in his fight to preserve and restore human rights in this country.

In company with the majority of the members of the California delegation in the House of Representatives, I appeared before the committee on merchant marine and fisheries in behalf of a bill to restore shipbuilding to the Pacific coast.

The bill provides for an amendment permitting ship building companies on the Pacific coast to borrow money for the construction of new ships at three-fourths of one per cent less rate interest than is paid by the borrowers for ship building on the Atlantic coast. It is estimated that this lesser rate would enable the Pacific coast yards to compete with the Atlantic coast. The amendment, however, limits this differential to ships that are built for Pacific coast trade. The members from the Pacific coast realize that this proposal will have rough sledding but we are not overlooking a chance to secure some ships for the yards on the Pacific.
