Compton Jaycee Opens Football Season Friday

First Game Tomorrow Night Against San Bernardino Junior College

Seeking to avenge its last year's defeat, Compton Junior College clashes with San Bernardino Jaycees in its initial game of the 1935 season Friday night at Compton. The Compton-San Bernardino tilt will be the first game played under the arcs at the Tartar institution. The game will start at 7:30 p. m.

Both Compton and San Bernardino are rated among the strongest Jaycee eleven in Southern California. The two teams are both pointing for this game. San Bernardino hopes to make it two wins in a row. They upset the Tartars 12-0 last year for the first time.

In previous meetings between the two eleven, Compton has walloped the Indians, and they are determined to avenge last year's defeat.

Several veterans, who played in last year's Tartar-San Bernardino game, will start Friday night's tilt. Three Tartar backs, Dick Rodriguez and Pat Eaton, half-backs, and James Twombly, full-back, who saw action in the 1934 game, may start in the backfield for the Tartars.
