Burglary In Wholesale Lots
 Furniture and costly ornaments in truckloads were removed from homes in the Palos Verdes Estates and Hollywood Riviera last week, the loss running to several hundred dollars. At the home of Mrs. Rose M. Rapaport, 6604 Via Colimita, goods estimated at \$1,329.35 were taken, the loss being reported on December 7. An 11-year-old bulldog was also missing, according to the report on file at sheriff's sub-station No. 3.

On Thursday, December 5, Leo B. Loeb, 234 Paseo de Graseo, Hollywood Riviera, reported to Torrance police the loss of furniture and other valuable articles amounting to \$1,172.40. His loss is covered by burglary insurance in the amount of \$1,500. In neither case did the wholesale marauders leave any clues.

On December 6, Edgar Hansen, 2637 Monte Vista, South Lomita, reported the theft of goods and jewelry amounting to \$131. Entrance in this instance was made by cutting a screen in a bedroom window.

of the total for the Los Angeles high school district. The total high school district bonded debt as of June 30, 1935, was \$23,838,637.20. The above percentage of the outstanding bonded debt would amount to \$352,408.14 as the proportion applicable to the Torrance district.

Auditor Rambo stated to the Herald that officials of the Board of Education had informed him that cartilage damages had been written off the valuations of all school buildings. In view of this fact, the high values which are placed upon Torrance schools are difficult to understand. For instance, the school board puts a value of \$35,089.69 upon the school at Walteria, presumably covering the brick building, which has been abandoned due to earthquake damage. The only buildings now being used at Walteria are a few wooden bungalows which by any stretch of the imagination could not be worth the figure given.

Our Share Indefinite
 In commenting upon the above valuations, Auditor Rambo says, "We are unable to ascertain the accuracy of these valuations. In fact, it would seem that only by actual appraisal may present valuations be accurately determined. We are also unable to state the amount or proportion of capital outlay during prior years that has been paid from revenue derived from the sale of bonds, or on the other hand, the amount or proportion of such expenditures that has to date been liquidated through bond redemptions by special district taxes. Both of these factors must be considered in establishing the amount of outstanding bonded debt that would be assumed by creation of a new district."

The following is an excerpt from section 2.73 of the school code:
 "When any new school district shall be formed from a portion of the territory of one or more existing districts, either by incorporation of a city or town, or otherwise, the board of supervisors of the county shall, within 60 days after the formation of such new district, by order entered on its minutes, determine what proportion of the outstanding bonded indebtedness of the districts out of which the said new district is formed, is incurred for the acquisition or improvement of school lots or buildings or fixtures therein situated in such new district, and the said new district shall thereupon become liable for the proportion of such indebtedness so determined."
