## Tail Wagger Foundation Launched At Meeting In Altadena Sunday

More than 250 Southern California canines, including blue blooded champions, prize pets of Hollywood's screen stars, and pedigreeless "pups" of many a youngster gathered at the Altadena estate of Albert Baron on Sunday for the first assembly of the Tail Wagger Foundation of America. In other words the bow-wows came to pow-wow, to inscribe their paw prints on the great register and to receive their identification medallions, destined to insure prompt recovery in case of loss, as their masters and mistresses discussed the purposes of the organization.

Leo V. Youngworth, chairman of the organization committee; Albert Baron, chairman of the board of directors, and Philip R. Brand, heading the board of governors, outlined the objects of the canine protective organization to the assembly of society leaders, film celebrities and just plain honest-to-goodness dog owners and dog lovers.

"To promote dog welfare all over America is the purpose of the Tail Wagger Foundation of America. It is a non-profit California corporation, all corporate officers serving gratuitously. "Life memberships for dogs are one dollar, and any dog can be enrolled by sending check, mail order or registered letter to the Registrar, Tail Wagger Foundation, 1687 North Vine Street, Los Angeles. Name of dog, breed, color, age, sex, and distinguishing marks should accompany the remittance." Mr. Youngworth explained, as he told of daily mails bringing heavy enrollments. "Its purposes are to secure recognition of rights of America's 8,500,000 dog owners who represent a canine investment of approximately \$500,000,000; sponsor legislation beneficial to dogs and their owners; prosecute dog poisoners and dog-nappers; provide dog shelters; organize recovery bureaus for lost tail waggies; correct unjust dog ordinances; educate children in animal kindness; advise owners on care and feeding; and properly handle the stray dog situation."

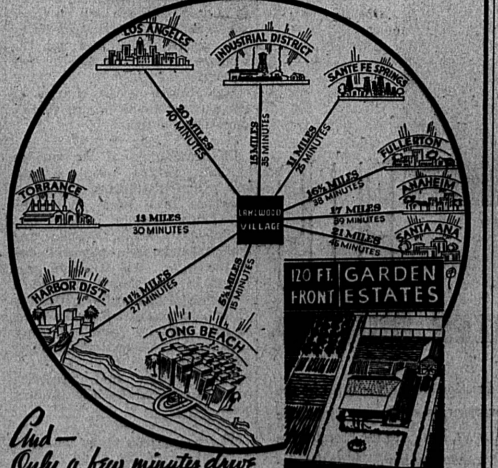
## Hit-Run Car Scalps San Diego Woman
