New Electrical Shop Opened On Cabrillo Ave. This Week

Equipped with one of the most modern sets of automobile motor analyzing machines in the bay district, the Torrance Auto Electrical Service shop, opened for business this week at 1320 Cabrillo avenue.

"We have separate units of equipment for testing each separate system of an auto motor," Fred C. Morgan, owner and manager of the new shop explained.

"By use of these machines, all guesswork in checking inefficiencies of motor operation is eliminated. For instance, you find that a carburetor is giving some trouble," Mr. Morgan motioned to a piece of equipment.

"Just connect the Weidenhoff carburetor analyzer to the exhaust and immediately the necessary adjustment of the carburetor, the amount of carbon present in the cylinders, and other such information is registered here."

Mr. Morgan explained that through this modern method of motor analysis a great many hours of expensive mechanic's time used in the trial and error method is saved.

"By using different pieces of equipment here in the shop we are able to locate any trouble present in the engine quickly and easily," He said.

Mr. Morgan and his family first came to California in 1923 from Homestead, Penn., where he was in the automobile repair business. Shortly after his arrival on the Pacific coast he established a shop similar to the one he has now brought to Torrance, in South Gate. All in all, Mr. Morgan has had 26 years experience in the automobile business.

He and his wife, two boys and two girls, intend to make their home in Torrance as soon as they are able to find accommodations.

Ed Thompson Initiates New Auto Service
