Woman Hurt As Car Overturns

Mrs. Nina Harris, 250 Pacific avenue, Long Beach, was treated for bruises and shock at the Jared Sidney Torrance Memorial hospital early Sunday morning following an automobile accident at 190th and Western avenue. The driver of the car in which four persons were riding failed to see the jog in the road at this point, and the car dashed into a field and overturned.

Several accidents have occurred at this point, for the same cause, as the only warning sign is a red light at the south side of the intersection. Persons unfamiliar with the highway are not prepared for the turn. Other signs giving notice of the jog in the highway should be posted at a suitable distance on either side of the intersection.

MARSHMALLOW CAKE

- 1/2 cup shortening
1 1/2 cups sugar
1/2 cup milk
3 cups flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
4 egg whites
1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon vanilla

Method: Cream shortening, add sugar gradually. Mix and sift dry ingredients, flour, baking powder, cream of tartar and salt; add them alternately with milk to creamed mixture. Lastly add stiffly beaten egg whites and the flavoring. Bake in layer cake pan about 30 minutes in a moderate oven (350 degrees). Put layers together with marshmallow frosting and ice with French cream frosting.

QUICK NUT LOAF

- 1/2 cup sugar
5 tablespoons shortening
2 cups flour
1 cup milk
1 tablespoon baking powder
1 teaspoon salt
1 egg and 1 egg yolk
1/2 cup chopped nuts

Method: Cream sugar, shortening, add beaten egg, milk and dry ingredients. Add nuts, flour and slightly. Beat well and let stand in pan 20 minutes before baking. Bake slowly.

DATE AND NUT COOKIES

- 1 1/2 cups sugar
1/2 cup shortening
3 beaten eggs
3 tablespoons molasses
2 1/2 cups flour
1 pound cut-up dates
1 small teaspoon cinnamon
1 small teaspoon cloves
1 small teaspoon nutmeg
1 small teaspoon vanilla
1 rounded teaspoon soda (Sealed)

Method: Cream sugar and shortening. Add molasses and eggs. Combine and add dry ingredients. Add soda and nuts last and drop from spoon on a greased pan.

MEAT BALLS, MEXICAN

- 2 cups cold ground meat
1/2 cup cold mashed potatoes or rice
1 egg
1 teaspoon chili powder
Mix well and brown. Pour following sauce over it:
1 cup tomatoes
2 tablespoons flour
3 tablespoons minced onion
2 tablespoons minced onion
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon chili powder
Blend flour and butter, then add the ingredients. Cook well and pour over balls.

PEACH-RICE PUDDING

- 2 cups cooked rice
1/2 cup milk
1/2 cup peach juice
1 egg, well beaten
1/4 cup sugar
2 teaspoons shortening
2 teaspoons lemon juice
1/4 teaspoon grated lemon rind
1/4 teaspoon salt

Method: Mix all ingredients together. Arrange on top six canned or fresh peach halves, filling cavities with three tablespoons chopped nuts, one tablespoon melted shortening and four tablespoons powdered sugar. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees), one hour or until firm.

CHESS CAKES

Mix together two-thirds cup sugar, two ounces shortening, one unbeaten egg, two-thirds cup chopped walnuts and two-thirds cup raisins (cut in half). Place in muffin tins, lined with pastry and bake 30 minutes in moderate oven.

Carrying the message of the National Air Races to be held in Los Angeles, September 4 to 7, race headquarters at the Ambassador hotel began distribution of 500,000 windshield stickers. The races this year will attract the cream of world fliers and will be international in scope. Total prize money amounts to \$1,000,000 more than was offered at Cleveland last year. Feature events will include the Bendix transcontinental speed dash from New York to Los Angeles, September 4, the Ruth Chatterton Handicap Derby for Sportsman pilots, from Cleveland, August 22, the Grove trophy race, the Shell trophy race, and the International free-for-all Thompson speed classic, Labor Day, September 7th.

SPANISH STEAK Have steak cut two inches thick. Put one tablespoon of oil or shortening in hot skillet, put in round steak, then one tablespoon oil on top of steak and sear both sides under flame. Take out, season and dredge all over with flour. For two pounds of steak, take one small onion, chop very fine and sprinkle over top of steak. Cover tightly and put in oven. Bake for five minutes, take out and pour over all one can of tomato sauce. Season lightly, cover tight and put back in oven for 10 minutes. Turn flame down a little, then if steak is tender sprinkle grated cheese over all and brown lightly without lid. Serve at once. Can be prepared in 20 to 25 minutes and will make nice gravy.
