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BAKED HAM SLICE IS TEMPTING



Tempting? Certainly this baked ham slice is enough to tempt even the most jaded appetite. It is a favorite not only with the diners, but also with the housewife who has the meal preparation on her shoulders...

The ham slice shown here is a center slice. This cut makes the best appearance, but if center slices are not available, have thick double slices cut from the ham butt, the center being cut not quite through, so that the double slice may be opened to form a single slice resembling a center cut slice in appearance.

Frankfurters Are Popular In Summer

More than a quarter billion pounds of frankfurters are sold annually in the United States, a fact which in itself indicates that this meat has gained a prominent place in the American diet.

Probably the larger part of this quarter billion pounds is consumed in summer time when wiener roasts are in order and when red-hot sandwiches are sold at every baseball and amusement park in the land.

Have you experimented with frankfurters to find new ways to prepare them? Miss Inez S. Willson, home economist, suggests a few which are excellent for Sunday night supper when guests have dropped in, or for that matter when only the family is present.

Stuffed Frankfurters. Choose large frankfurters. Split them lengthwise and spread the cut surfaces with mustard. Place a slice of cheese in the center and wrap the stuffed frankfurter with a slice of uncooked bacon.

Red-Hot Crown. Choose large frankfurters of uniform size. Thread these onto a string so that they form the shape of a crown, with the concave side of the frankfurters toward the outside.

Any kind of bread dressing may be used with the frankfurter crown, but here is one which is particularly good: 1/2 pound bulk sausage, 1/2 cup grated onion, 2 frankfurters, sliced, 1 loaf bread, finely diced, 1 egg, salt and pepper.

Frankfurters en Casserole. Split the frankfurters lengthwise and arrange in a casserole with alternate layers of cooked lima beans and frankfurters. Dot with butter, cover and bake until thoroughly heated through.

Method: Select a slice of ham cut 1 to 1 1/2 inches thick. Put in a baking dish and pour over it a sauce made from vinegar, sugar, paprika and mustard. Dot with whole cloves and bake in a slow oven until the ham is done, about one hour.
