Big Double Circus Will Come to Long Beach Next Week, Oct. 3-4

In 1930 Barlow entered business for himself by establishing a trouble shooting service for bar equipment. Shortly afterwards he bought his present establishment and a year later purchased the business block in which his cafe is located.
