### PINEAPPLE COFFEE CAKE

- 2 cups flour
- 3 teps. baking powder
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1/2 cup melted shortening
- 1/2 cup crushed pineapple
- 1 tsp. cinnamon
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 8 tbsps. butter

Measure and sift dry ingredients. Beat egg, add milk and shortening. Combine liquid and dry materials quickly, spread in oiled pan. Thoroughly drain pineapple and arrange over dough. Sprinkle with cinnamon, sugar and butter. Bake at 375 degrees for 30 minutes.

### CHIPPED BEEF Variety Is Sunday NITE SUCCESS

- 1 cupful of chipped beef
- 2 tablespoons of butter
- 2 tablespoons of flour
- 2 cupfuls of milk
- Omelet made of: 2 eggs 4 tablespoons of water or milk 1 tablespoonful of chopped green pepper Salt and pepper 6 slices of toast, or patty shells

First prepare the creamed chipped beef; frizzle the torn beef in the butter, add the flour and stir well, then add the milk and cook, stirring until smoothly thickened. Make the omelet as usual, heating the eggs with the milk, green pepper and seasonings, and cooking until firm and lightly browned in hot butter. Cut the omelet into bits and stir into the creamed beef, and serve on toast or in timbale or patty shells. This makes an attractive luncheon or supper dish, serving six.—V. S. Los Gatos, Calif.

- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 No. 1 can bean sprouts
- 1 medium sized onion
- 1/2 cup diced celery
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 3 tablespoons sucy sauce

Method: Cut meat in small pieces and brown. Dice onions, add to meat and brown. Then add the rest of the ingredients. Add about a cup of water to keep from burning. Cover. Cook at a high temperature for 20 minutes, reduce heat and cook slowly for one hour.

### PEANUT COOKIES

- 2 cups brown sugar
- 1 cup butter
- 2 eggs
- 1 teaspoon soda
- 3 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon cream of tartar
- 1 cup chopped peanuts

Method: Cream butter; add sugar and beaten eggs. Sift flour, soda and cream of tartar together and add to above mixture. Add peanuts. Chill dough, then roll and cut. Cook 10 to 12 minutes.

  - 2 cups milk
  - 1/2 teaspoon salt
  - 1 teaspoon vanilla
  - 1 cup red cherries
  - 1/2 cup diced marshmallows
  - 1/2 cup nuts
  - 6 slices sponge cake
- Method: Blend flour and sugar, add egg yolks and milk. Cook in double boiler until thick and creamy, stirring frequently. Cool and add salt, extract and cherries. Chill. Serve poured over cake and top with marshmallows and nuts. Other fruits can be used in place of cherries.
