Woman Injured In Fall or Leap From Moving Car

Husband Relates Her Threat To Jump After Argument

Mrs. Florence Hatcher, 1134 Stanley avenue, Long Beach, is recovering this week at the Jared Sidney Torrance Memorial hospital from a severe concussion of the brain, sustained when she either fell or jumped from her husband's car at Western and Riverside-Redondo boulevard Sunday morning.

Merrill Hatcher, the husband, drove up to the Torrance police station shortly after midnight of Sept. 27 to inquire the way to the hospital, telling officers that his wife had been badly injured.

Later he told police that the couple had made the rounds of a number of drink emporiums and were on their way home when a dispute arose between him and his wife, and that she had threatened to jump out of the car. Whether she did so, or whether she opened the door and fell to the pavement, is not known. The car, Hatcher stated, was being driven at about 35 miles an hour.

Mrs. Hatcher was believed at first to have sustained a fractured skull but x-rays disclosed no injuries to the bone. The case has been turned over to deputy sheriffs of Sub-station No. 3 for further investigation.
