Walteria Bus Effort Fails

Apparently there is nothing the city of Torrance can do to obtain free school bus transportation for Walteria pupils to the Narbonne high school. This became evident last night as City Attorney C. T. Rippey read a lengthy opinion and statement from Attorney General U. S. Webb.

Although the distance from the homes of 34 pupils whose parents petitioned for the free transportation to the high school in Lomita is approximately three miles, the Los Angeles board of education has declined to provide this gratis service and is not bound by any law to do so. The board has said the cost would be prohibitive. It agrees that the distance is excessive but has announced that it would only furnish free transportation to those unable to pay.

From Rippey's and Webb's statements, it was evident that the only recourse is to have the state legislature change the statutes regarding school transportation. Webb's opinion, while not based on the Walteria case, was about a similar situation in Siskiyou county.

Women WPA Workers Laid Off In County

More than 2000 women with dependent children have been laid off of their Works Progress Administration jobs in Los Angeles county, and an additional 800 were to be laid off this week, according to information released from the Los Angeles office of the WPA.

This move is in accordance with the workings of the Federal Social Security Act and only those who are eligible for aid are being transferred. In this instance women who have dependent children under the age of 18 are affected. A recent survey has revealed that the dependent children are receiving inadequate attention while their mothers have been working with the WPA. Fourteen Torrance women were dismissed from the sewing project here.
