WHAT can you spare from the jelly cupboard for Christmas giving? Pity the business women, bachelors and those away from home. Give them a half dozen glasses of something good to eat. Something to spread thick on breakfast toast, or to fluff a roll or cracker. Something that can be shipped and kept indefinitely. Your home-made jams and jellies.

Are you afraid the contents of your jelly cupboard won't last until Spring? You're not so sure. No need to worry against your conscience. Delicious jams, jellies and marmalades can be made from dried fruits, canned fruits and juices, and fresh citrus fruits, provided, of course, you use bottled or powdered fruit pectin.

### JURY CLEARS BOY-DRIVER

Negligence, and Liquor Are Held Cause of Death

Testimony that George Traynor, 65, who was instantly killed late last week when run down on Normandie avenue near Carson street by the northbound auto of Ted James Harper, 16-year-old Gardena student, was under the influence of liquor caused a coroner's jury to exonerate young Harper here Monday afternoon.

The accident was ascribed to Traynor's negligence by the jury summoned for the inquest held at Stone and Myers chapel, Traynor, who was retired, lived at the rear of 22424 South Normandie, near Torrance. Arthur Thrallkill, 19, of Los Angeles, one of four youths riding with Harper, was treated at a receiving hospital for forehead lacerations and glass in the eyes. Harper was not hurt in the accident.

**Ginger-Apricot Jam**  
4 cups (1 lb.) prepared fruit  
1/2 cup (1/4 lb.) sugar  
1 cup (1/2 lb.) sugar  
1 bottle fruit pectin  
To prepare fruit, add 3/4 cup water to about 1/2 pound dried apricots, cover, and let stand 4 hours or overnight. Drain, fruit, grind, or chop fine, and mix with juice. Chop fine about 1/2 pound crystallized ginger.

Measure sugar and prepared fruit into large kettle, filling up last cup with water if necessary. Add ginger, mix well, and bring to a full rolling boil over hottest fire. Stir constantly before and while boiling. Boil hard 3 minutes. Remove from fire and stir in bottled fruit pectin. Stir, pour quickly. Pour into hot jars at once. Makes about 11 glasses (6 fluid ounces each).

### MAN'S BODY DISCOVERED

Identification Is Believed to Be Impossible

### LICENSE RENEWAL EXPLAINED

Motorists will be able to secure their 1937 license plates with a minimum of inconvenience from Jan. 3 to midnight, Feb. 1, reports the license department of the National Automobile Club.

The confusion and special tax problems of previous years have been greatly modified by the Department of Motor Vehicles. Every registered car owner will be mailed a tax postcard on Dec. 26. These cards will show the vehicle license fee which must be paid in addition to the usual \$3 registration fee on pleasure cars. This license fee tax replaces the personal property taxes formerly paid on automobiles to the city and county in which the owner resided.

Unless the 1936 license number and description of the car shown on the tax card does not correspond to the white certificate. Any alteration or erasure on the tax card will void same. Motorists are warned to check the address shown on their 1936 white certificate. If you have moved during the year and have failed to notify the Motor Vehicle Department of your new address, do so at once so that you will receive the tax card that will be mailed out Dec. 26, with white registration certificate. Tax cards must be presented with white registration certificates in order to obtain renewal of license plates.
