One-Half of Deaths

One-Half of Deaths In Los Angeles Co. From Natural Cause

Only one-half of the 422 persons who died in Los Angeles county last month died of natural causes, according to the May report of Coroner Frank A. Nance. Only 212 of the 422 died a natural death. Motor vehicles were responsible for the deaths of 74 persons, falls brought death to 26 more and 41 took their own lives. Homicides ranked next with 14 lives and alcoholism almost tied the homicides with 19. Of the 422 deaths in the county in May. 276 were males and 146 were females. Airplanes took three lives, electric railways 3, steam fallways 2 lives, industrial accidents 6 lives, and infections 7.
