The goats on the island, numbering now some 25,000, according to estimate, are the descendants of domesticated animals left there many years ago. During the heydey of travel to California by sea, from 1840 to about 1865, numerous vessels were wyceked on San Clemente, and as it is of a barren, rugged character, skippers of other vessels conceived the idea of providing for castaways in landing soats, chickens, pigs and other livestock on the island. Of the varieties landed, ohly the goats were able to make a living and survive. The present stock has accommodated theelf, to the conditions, and now the goats bear very little resemblance to their timid, domesticated forefathers. They are heavier in body, short of, leg, long of horn, and their hoofs are large and toigh to withstand the shocks of Jumping from crag to crag.
