six will use 1500 cubic feet each per month, or a total added revenue of \$22.50 per month.

"4. That there are no new industrial or irrigation consumers secured during the period covered (a most improbable condition).

"5. That Torrance Municipal Water District purchases \$25,000 of its outstanding 6% bonds, funds for which are available.

"The analysis submitted will, in my opinion, show conclusively through the lowering of rates as indicated that all operating costs can be met, a reasonable depreciation fund be provided, and all obligations incurred by the sale of the \$200,000 six percent bonds and \$125,000 four percent bonds to the government can be met as to principal and interest."

The Summary accompanying the communication is on file in the office of the city engineer.


