

Mayor Shaw's Plan to Consolidate City & County Governments Scanned Lest Torrance Be made the "Goat"

Consolidation of the governments of the city and county of Los Angeles is favored in a report under consideration today by the special governmental committee of 21 appointed by Mayor Frank L. Shaw.

The report was prepared by John A. Rush, a temporary vice chairman of the committee who, however, expressed the desire that it be regarded wholly as his own attitude and not, for the present, an expression of the views of any group in the mayor's committee.

Rush declared that a 40 percent reduction of taxes was brought about in 1886 when the state legislature engated the city and county of San Francisco.

He cited similar consolidations of governmental functions carried out by Baltimore, Philadelphia, New Orleans, St. Louis and Deniver.

It was recommended that the committee consider seven possible ways for simplifying government and from them choose one plan for endorsement.

According to Rush, the next logical step would be the appointment of a legal committee to ascertain what legislation would be necessary for carrying out the proposal.
