NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals will be received up to 8:00 o'clock P. M. on Tuesday, November 12, 1935, by the City Council of the City of Torrance, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, in the office of the City Clerk in said City for the purchase of any or all of the following bonds of the City of Torrance, to-wit:

(2) "BUILDING BONDS, 1935"

Bonds designated and known as "Building Bonds, 1935" in the sum of \$50,000.00. Said bonds shall be thirty-five (35) in number, shall be dated October 1, 1935, and shall be of the denomination of \$1,000.00 each. Said bonds shall be payable in numerical order and shall be numbered and payable as follows:

All of the aforesaid "Public Hall Bonds, 1935" and said "Building Bonds, 1935" shall bear interest at a rate of not to exceed 6% per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of April and October of each year. Said bonds shall be payable at the office of the City Treasurer of Torrance, in the City of Torrance, County of Los Angeles, State of California, in such funds as are on the respective dates of payment of the principal and interest on the bonds legal tender for debts due the United States of America. Said bonds may be registered as to both principal and interest.

Said \$50,000.00 for said "Building Bonds, 1935" shall be issued in accordance with the provisions of an act of the legislature of the State of California entitled "An act authorizing the incurring of indebtedness by cities, towns and municipal corporations for municipal improvements, and regulating the acquisition, construction or completion thereof," which became a law February 25, 1901, and acts amendatory and supplementary thereto, and said \$35,000.00 of "Public Hall Bonds, 1935" shall be issued in accordance with the provisions of an act of the legislature of the State of California entitled "An act authorizing cities, towns and municipal corporations to establish and maintain public assembly or convention halls and to incur indebtedness for such improvements," which became a law March 25, 1903, and acts amendatory and supplementary thereto.

The aforesaid bonded indebtedness was authorized at a special election of the City of Torrance held on September 27, 1935, called by Ordinance No. 269 of the City of Torrance, and the issuance of said bonds will be in pursuance of the provisions of Ordinance No. 270 of said City of Torrance.

Ordinance No. 270, authorizing the issuance of said bonds, expressly provides that the City Council shall at the time of fixing the general tax levy and in the manner for such general tax levy provided, levy and collect annually each year until said respective bonds are paid, a tax sufficient to pay the annual interest and the part of the principal of said respective bonds as shall come due before the time of fixing the next general tax levy, and shall not at the time of fixing said general tax levy be otherwise provided for by funds then in the treasury and set apart for that purpose, and that said respective taxes shall be set aside in funds known respectively as "1935 Public Hall Bond Interest and Redemption Fund" and "1935 Building Bond Interest and Redemption Fund," and shall be applied exclusively to the payment of said respective bonds.

the Mayor of said City of Torrance must accompany each bid as a guarantee that the bidder, if successful, will accept and pay for the bonds described in the accepted bid in accordance with the terms of his bid, and said check shall remain in the possession of the Mayor until all of said bonds are paid for and successful bidder shall fail or refuse to accept and pay for said bonds, at which time said Mayor shall endorse and cash said check and deposit the proceeds thereof in the hands of the City Treasurer of said City of Torrance, or return said check to the bidder in event he shall have fully paid said City for the bonds purchased.
