MAMMAL FOSSIL CALLED 180 MILLION YEARS OLD

JOHANNESBURG. (U.P.) —A lofossil believed to be between to 170,000,000 and 180,000,000 years old has been unearthed by a

Dr. Robert Broom, noted South fossil is in a nearly perfect state. It belongs to a group of cold-blooded vegetarlan mammal-like reptiles known as the kannemeyeria. It is shaped like a tortoise and eight feet in length, and is believed to have had large tusks and probably a scaly skin like a fish.
