breakage in rimiess glasses was
due to excessive pressure on the
glass. This pressure was necessary to hold the frames securely, and any slight jar or extraordinary-strain would break the
glass, usually at the screw hole.

Iske Rivets

"The new method of attaching
the frame to the glass is very
similar to the manner in which
rivets are used to hold steel
plates together. Instead of, a
screw we use a small length of
metal that is inserted into the
frame holes and then thru the
glass, This is then placed in
the special instrument and with
the use of electricity, the metal
is heated and the ends fused
over and around the frame
holes. This seals the glass to
the frame with just the correct
amount of pressure, and at no
time is there excessive strain
around the contact point of the
