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Martin and Osa Johnson

LOS ANGELES, Jan. 14, (U.P.)—What the wildest jungles of Africa and Borneo could not do, a California mountain did—claimed the life of one of this modern age's greatest explorers, Martin Johnson. He died yesterday, second victim of 13 men and women aboard a Western Air Express sky liner which crashed Monday in a snowstorm within—15 miles of its Burbank destination on a flight from Sait Lake City.

Mrs. Osa Johnson, his wife and constant companion on big game trips with a camera as a weapon, lies seriously injured in a hospital here, uninformed of his death. Just before the takeoff of the fattal flight, Johnson remarked:

"America, probably because it is the most dungerous," And Mrs. Johnson echoed this thought with: "I actually feel uneasy when away from the jungles."
