LEG OF LAMB FOR SUNDAY DINNER



Lamb is a favorite for Sunday dinner at all times of the year, but right now it deserves special mention because there is an abundance of unusually high-quality lamb on the market. The roast leg of lamb, shown above, though one of the nicest, is one of the easiest meat dishes to prepare. There is no last minute hurry or flurry if the roasting is done according to the newest methods of cooking.

The roast is simply placed, fat side up, in an open roasting pan and allowed to roast in a slow oven (300-350°F) until done. It requires 30 to 35 minutes per pound for roasting lamb.

Many connoisseurs of cookery insist that in order to appreciate the true flavor of lamb, it should be cooked just "short" of well-done, so that it has a slight pinkish tinge rather than the familiar gray of well-done meat. If you prefer lamb this way, shorten the cooking time a little.

Leave "Fell" On. In serving lamb, be sure to serve it very hot or very cold, but never lukewarm. The leg of lamb pictured above is "Frenched" at the market; that is, the meat is removed from the end of the rib bone. After it is roasted, a paper frill may be slipped over this bone if desired, and if so, it makes a convenient handle in carving.

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MWD Queried On Land Annexation

Part of Ventura County May Join District

Annexation of a large area in southeastern Ventura county to the Metropolitan Water District has been advanced in an informal application received by the district board of supervisors.

Signed by Wayne W. Montgomery, chairman of the water committee for southeastern Ventura county, the application stated that a representative group of property owners in that territory was interested in securing water from the MWD and wished to be advised as to the steps to be taken to effect an annexation of their territory to the district.

This application, it was stated, was made following a recent meeting of members of the Ventura county group with officials of the MWD. The matter has been turned over to the Water Problems committee of the district board of directors. During the past year the MWD directors received requests for information relative to joining the district from areas totaling approximately 400,000 acres, and extending from Ventura county to the city of San Diego.
