SACRAMENTO, March 18—(U.P.)—Speed and death rode hand in hand on California highways, in 1936, telaming the greatest toil of life in the state's history.

Pleading for safer driving and less speed, Ray Ingels, director of the state department of motor vehicles, said California's traffic death toil of 3,132 was, the highest in the nation. Final tabulations showed the 1936 casualty list to exceed by 11.6 percent that of 1935.


