REFRIGERATOR

Desserts Give Happy Ending to Dinners

Refrigerator desserts made with sweetened condensed milk are a boon to the housewife who answers the lure of the spring sunshine and goes out for tennis or golf, a walk or work in garden beds and borders. For these failure-proof, delicious desserts are quick and easy to make and really save time that may be spent outdoors. They can be prepared hours before they are needed, tucked into the refrigerator to ripen and chill, and then brought out at dessert time all ready to serve. And they assure a happy ending to any meal.

Maple Refrigerator Cake
 1 1/2 cups (1 can) sweetened condensed milk
 1/2 cup maple syrup
 1/2 cup whipping cream
 24 vanilla wafers
 Thoroughly blend sweetened condensed milk and maple syrup in a heavy saucepan. Bring to boil over low heat and boil, stirring constantly, about four minutes, until mixture thickens. Cool. Beat cream until stiff and fold into mixture. Line narrow, oblong pan with wax paper. Cover with maple mixture. Add layer of wafers, alternating in this way until maple mixture is used, finishing with layer of wafers. Chill in refrigerator for six hours or longer. To serve, turn out on small platter and carefully remove wax paper. Cut in slices and serve plain or with whipped cream. Serves eight.

Mocha Refrigerator Cake
 2 squares unsweetened chocolate
 1 1/2 cups (1 can) sweetened condensed milk
 1/2 cup strong coffee
 1/2 cup Brazil nut meats, finely chopped
 24 vanilla wafers
 Melt chocolate in top of double boiler. Add sweetened condensed milk and stir over boiling water five minutes, or until mixture thickens. Add coffee and Brazil nut meats, blending thoroughly. Line narrow, oblong pan with wax paper. Place eight vanilla wafers on bottom of pan; cover with layer of chocolate. Add another layer of wafers, alternating in this way until chocolate mixture is used, finishing with eight vanilla wafers. Chill in refrigerator for 12 hours or longer. To serve, turn out on small platter and carefully remove wax paper. Cut in slices or squares to serve. Garnish with whipped cream. Serves eight.

RECORD SHOWS SUSAN ANTHONY VOTED IN 1870
 BUFFALO, N. Y., April 15 (U.P.)—The story of a woman who voted half a century before any other woman—and was arrested for it—has been unearthed in the old U. S. District Court here.

The story was told in a handwritten document marked "Exhibit B" in the case of the United States vs. Susan B. Anthony. It was part of the transcript of the trial of Susan B. Anthony, pioneer suffragist, held at Canandaigua, N. Y., June 17, 1873. Present at the trial was Millard Fillmore, later President of the United States.

Miss Anthony, according to the testimony of W. W. James, inspector in a Rochester, N. Y., election district, entered the voting booth on election day, 1870. "She came in," Jones testified, "and asked if this was the place to register. We said it was, and she claimed the right to vote as a citizen under the Fifteenth amendment. She was challenged by several persons, but voted anyway."

A verdict of guilty on the charge of "voting without having a lawful right" was directed against Miss Anthony by the court. She was remanded to jail when she refused to give bail. Her attorney, however, later posted bail, but the record did not show whether Miss Anthony was ever returned to prison.
