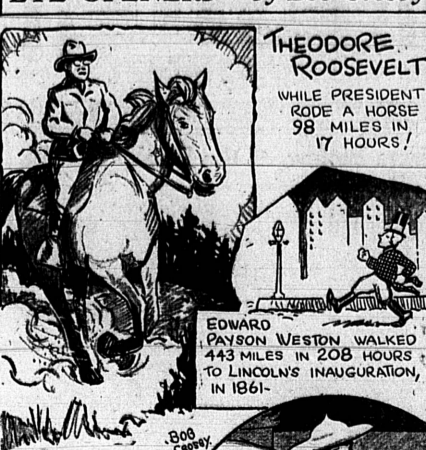

EDWARD PAYSON WESTON WALKED 443 MILES IN 208 HOURS TO LINCOLN'S INAUGURATION, IN 1861.

YEARS AGO, IN CHINA, NATURAL GAS WAS TRANSPORTED THROUGH PIPE LINES OF BAMBOO ...

President Roosevelt, in February, 1909, rode ninety-eight miles on horseback in seventeen hours of daylight. Using three horses, he rode from Washington to Warren, and return.

Edward Payson Weston began his career as a professional pedestrian in 1867, but it was his 443-mile jaunt in 208 hours to the inauguration of Lincoln in 1861 that brought him fame.

A far cry from the early bamboo pipes of the Chinese is the 22,000-mile network of transmission and distribution lines serving natural gas to a population of 5,000,000 in California alone. Some lines are as large as 26 inches in diameter.

Letters Reveal Torrance Girl and Ritchie Saw Coronation

In her first two letters to her parents here, Neva June Lowen revealed that she is having the time of her 11-year-old life in England and that the Coronation of King George VI and Queen Elizabeth was a wonderful pageant—because of the "pretty horses."

Mr. and Mrs. C. D. Lowen of 904 Beech street have permitted The Herald to publish excerpts from their daughter's letters. The first was written aboard the S. S. Berengaria, en route to England, and says:

"Dear Mother and Daddy: 'I just came out of the swimming pool. We use the pool between 10 and 12 o'clock. I can swim pretty well now.

"There are sure some good looking English boys on this ship."

"Our beds are as comfortable as mine at home. I have slept well these two nights. We have good meals, too! Our waiter is awfully nice. The only trouble is they don't have seafood cocktails—but they have plenty of other good things. We have fish every day, and I'm getting used to it. The first night we had a carnival dinner, with hats, balloons, etc. I put my balloon on the seat in the stateroom, went out, and when we came back it was gone! But we think it blew out the port hole.

Sees the Princess
"We had an awful time getting my passport and visa. If it hadn't been for our guide (Travelers' Aid), we wouldn't be sailing now. We just passed the 'Queen Mary' and I took some movies of her."

Neva June continued her correspondence on May 13:

"It is now the day after the coronation. We got up at 5:30. We started at 20 minutes to seven, and got there at 7 a. m. We waited until 2 p. m.—and then it started. The royal coach was beautiful—I saw the princess, too! and Queen Mother Mary and everybody! The king was as stiff and as solemn as a wax figure. There were sure a lot of pretty horses. I never saw so many horses in all my life!

I saw, for the first time, a band on horseback, with drums, bugles and everything. There were lots of bagpipers, too. I love them.

"I like it here because of the change. (Rather!). Give my love to everybody."

RITCHIE COVERED ROUTE OF CORONATION A-FOOT
According to a letter received this week, together with a copy of the London Evening News, A. J. Ritchie of this city, evidently saw the coronation procession from an excellent point of vantage. He wrote: "Have secured a splendid position to view the big doings tomorrow (May 12). The people are beginning to line the streets already which means an all-night sit-down."

"Have done over the whole route by foot and am still in a daze at the brilliance of the decorations and crowds. I will send you more British papers after the Coronation and then I'll hit out for Bonnie Scotland."
