The specially-constructed valves at the shore line between the submerged section and the tunnel section are being installed this week. These valves are built of a bronze metal, which will be resistant to sewerage gasses and sait in the sea water, Warren explained. The tunnel contractors now are cleaning up their work, installing short sections of invert that was omitted during the major tunnel lining operations by reasons of sidings in the tunnels and widened places for storage of materials. The tunnel is approximately 8 feet in diameter and penetrates the Palos Verdes Hills at a depth of 500 feet at some points.
