The President of the United States has proclaimed the week beginning October 3, 1937 as Fire Prevention Week. In his proclamation he invites the cooperation of everyone to the end that the nation's fire losses be reduced.

Although there has been a decline in the fire loss for five years, this record was marred in 1936 by an increase from the preceding year of more than \$28,000,000, bringing 'the total destruction by fire in 1938 to \$263,299,746, 11.9 percent above the 1935 figure. Moreover, in 1936 more than 10,000 persons were burned to death or lost their lives as a result of fires and many thousand more were injured. The nation's fire waste is chiefly due to carelessness and the important lesson that should be taught during Fire Prevention week is the need for exercising care at all times.
