Reelamation Service, said water will be flowing in the ditch by the spring of 1939-making available for cultivation 500,000 acres of land, the larg-est irrigation district in North America, if not in the world. **Engineering Problems Difficult** In the construction of the canal, tremendous engineering problems were overcome before the operation of the big ditch could be assured of success. Undesirable silt deposits, which have been a problem to Im-perial Valley farmers since Col-orado River water first was di-verted for irrigation, will be eliminated by a desting plant, which will sluice heavier silt back into the river below Im-perial Dam.
