ORDINANCE NO. 299

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR KEEPING AND RUNNING AT LARGE OF CERTAIN ANIMALS AND FOWLS WITHIN THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

The City Council of the City of Torrance, California, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or maintain more than two (2) rabbits and their offspring under the age of four months, or to keep more than two dozen chickens or more than one dozen turkeys, if the same are kept or maintained nearer than one hundred fifty feet to the residence, or dwelling house of any other person in the City of Torrance. It shall be unlawful to keep any such rabbits, chickens or turkeys on any portion of any lot except the rear portion.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or maintain any guinea fowl, rooster, ducks, geese, turkeys and/or pigeons, in any closely built up section of the City of Torrance.

Section 3. Any section or district shall be considered closely built up within the meaning of this ordinance if there shall be more than three residences on either or both sides of any street within any one block, and any person so keeping or maintaining any such fowl shall be deemed to be keeping same within any such district if such fowl are kept or maintained within three hundred feet of any such house in said district.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to allow rabbits, chickens, ducks, geese or any domestic fowl to roam at large upon any streets, parks, alleys or other public places, or upon any private property not in the possession of the owner or person having control of any such animal or fowl.

Section 5. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to allow any goats, sheep, cattle, or any other animal excepting dogs, to run at large, or to be tethered or confined in any manner to any place in the City of Torrance, within one hundred (100) feet of any dwelling house of any other person.

Section 6. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00, or by term of not more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
