Paris Styles by ... MARY FENTRESS

PARIS (U.P.)—Knitted afternoon frocks with high necklines swathing the throat, broad sashes, detail and lace effects are a feature of Anny Blatt's midseason collection in which she introduces a new "woven and knit" combination.

Casual knitted skirts with soft cashmere sweaters in gray, black flecked with red or white and tweed patterns are designed in novelty stitches. Smart daytime frocks are shown with a deep band on the lower part of the skirt knitted to give the effect of knife-pointing.

Tucked and puffed effects are numerous. One turquoise suit of ribbed design is trimmed at the front of the jacket with double "ladder" effect of horizontal detail, the wide leaders for a brown leather belt following the horizontal design.

A distinctive black dress of the "knit and woven" type is made with high-cut neckline which opens at the throat, long fitted sleeves and a knitted sash of red and purple. With it is worn a hip-length loose-cut jacket.

Wool and silk are combined in a black afternoon dress with close-knit straight skirt and lace blouse, the silk giving a lustrous banded effect. Another costume incorporates the current corset band at the waistline. A Southern wear ensemble in the collection is a white double-breasted knitted coat with matching skirt and wine-hued loose-knit sweater.

A current red crocheted evening gown designed with gorges of flesh-hued crochet in the long classic skirtline is an interesting novelty. Giving the effect of a fine lace, the gown is designed with swathed waistline, close-fitting bodice and wide shoulder straps that cross high in front and form a draped cowl at the back.

Embroidered pencil stripes are a novelty for a two-piece gray knit with blocked effect on the lower part of the jacket, and a deep beige costuming is made with all-over design in small blocks, outlines in embroidery stitches.
