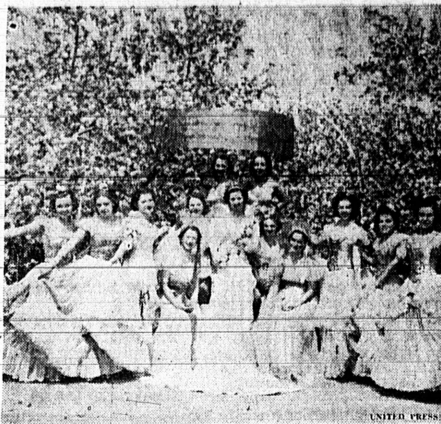

Change in Mileage Rate Paid County Workers Recommended

County employees, driving their own automobiles on county business, travel nearly 1,000,000 miles per month at a present cost to the county of more than \$36,000, the bureau of budget and research reported today in recommending a slightly higher base mileage rate, with two downward steps on increased mileage.

That the present mileage rate does not cover the costs to the employees, as various departments have complained to the board of supervisors, was conceded by the bureau. The new rate would add about \$3500 a month to the county's expenses.

The proposed rate, which will be considered by the board next week, calls for five cents a mile for the first 300 miles, instead of the present flat rate of four cents a mile; four cents for the next 300 miles and three and one-half cents a mile for any additional miles.

Prevents "Favoritism" — The higher number of miles driven in any period, the lower the cost per mile, the report said, since proprietary costs,

which include original cost, depreciation, licenses, taxes, insurance, storage and interest, are so widely spread out.

Taking a sample and checking speedometer readings, the bureau found that the 1,860 county employees reported average driving 630 miles on their own business or pleasure during the month and about 600 miles on the county's business.

But with only 40 percent of the number using their cars on county business driving 600 miles in the average month, it was declared necessary to utilize a two-step down-rate in order that the high-mileage driver might not be favored at the expense of the low-mileage driver, the report said.
