Local Relief Aid Computed for New Budget

Los Angeles county supervisors have taken into consideration the amount this city and the other 43 cities of the county received in unemployment relief funds in working out the county road and highway budget allotments for the coming fiscal year, because repayment is being made out of gasoline tax funds.

According to the supervisors' figures the city of Torrance had 43 percent of the total number of relief cases that were aided with the approximately \$13,000,000 of unemployment relief funds provided by a special bond issue in 1935.

In money, this amounted to \$55,331, according to the tabulation of Los Angeles city, with 60.16 percent of the relief load, alone accounted for \$7,741,160 of the total.

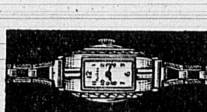
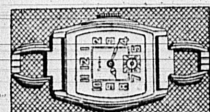
