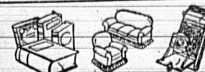

U.S.C. Holds Government Conclave



Seen are traffic engineers and police officials of State and local departments who are attending classes on traffic control and safety as one of sections featured at the 10th annual Institute of Government now in progress on the University of Southern California campus.

City officials from 65 California communities are meeting with State and Federal authorities to discuss current governmental problems at the University of Southern California campus.

Sponsored by S. C. under the direction of Dean Emery E. Olson of the school of government, 2,500 technical experts, departmental authorities, educators, and business executives as well as government employees are delving into 33 sections concerning administration affairs.

Delegates from Honolulu to New York, including nine Federal department heads from Washington, D. C., are discussing subjects of government in aviation, traffic control and safety, taxation, Federal grants-in-aid, problems of youth, and technical phases of health sanitation, water and power supply and engineering problems.

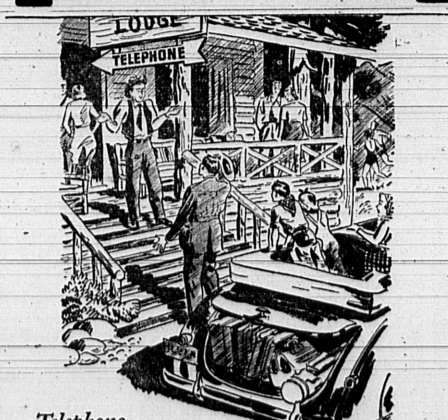
