

State Comes to Aid of County's 'Forgotten Dependent Children'

The state of California has come to the rescue of Los Angeles county's "forgotten chil-

dren."

At the insistence of the state department of social welfare County Superintendent of Charities Rex Thomson has recommended to the board of supervisors that the a mount allowed dependent children be increased by 15 percent.

creased by 15 percent.

The state department has just completed a survey which revealed that Los Angeles county was not allowing dependent children sufficient money to conform to the standards of living in San Francisco and Alameda counties, Thomson explained to the supervisors.

The state officials asked for a 46 percent increase to bring the thousands of dependent children here up to the level with those in the Northern California area. The increase asked by the state The increase asked by the state would have cost the county an additional \$1,001,857 this fiscal year, Thomson estimated. He estimated the modified 15 percent which he has recommended will cost but an additional \$325,700 this year.

Petitions asking for the incorporation of a portion of the Palos Verdes Estates as a city of the sixth class were on file today with the board of supervisors, with a request that steps be taken at once to call an election in the area.

A population of about 1,100 persons is included within the boundaries of the area it is proposed to incorporate, which would be on the most westerly projection and slope, between Malaga Cove and Lunada Bay.
