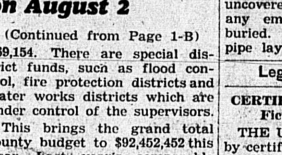
It Takes Light To Make Steel

L. B. Pageant to Chmax Jubilee Year Aug. 8-13

Four centuries of California history and legend will be dramatized in a two-hour pageant, the Salute to the States, to be presented outdoors at Long Beach on the evenings of Aug. 8 to 13. A cast of 600 will appear in the episodes depicting prehistoric Indian life in California, the discovery of San Pedro Bay in 1542 by Juan Rodriguez Cabrillo, the Mission Period, the period of the Spanish ranchos, the founding of Long Beach, the incorporation of the city 50 years ago, the discovery of oil on the coastal plain, and the pursuit of outdoor recreation in modern California.

Queens representing each of the 48 states will appear in a ceremony Aug. 6. A ball Aug. 6, a water circus Aug. 7 and several other preliminary events will be staged. The series of events will be the climax of the city's Golden Jubilee Year observance.
