



ORDINANCE NO. 306 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISH ING BUILDING LINES ALONG CERTAIN PORTIONS OF AR-LINGTON AVENUE, FROM RE-DONDO BEACH BOULEVARD TO 190TH STREET IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

of Torrance doverdain as follows, to-wit: .Section 1. It shall be unlaw-ful for any person, firm, or cor-poration to build, erect or con-struct, or to cause or permit to be built, erected or constructed any building or structure or any part or portion thereof, within a strip of land eighty (80) fect wide, lying forty (40) fect on either side and adjacent to the center line of Arlington avenue, as, established by the County Surveyor of the County of Los Angeles, and shown on County of Los Angeles, and shown on County Surveyor, ex-tending from the southerly line of Redondo Beach Boulevard, which line is also the northerly boundary of the City of Tor-rance, to the center line of 190th Street.

Street. Section 2. Any person, firm, or corporation or association of persons violating any of the pro-visions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misde-meanor and upon conviction thereof shall be puniShable by a fine of net to exceed five humfine of not to exceed five hun fred dollars (\$500.00) or by im-prisonment in the County Jai or not to exceed six (6) mon r by both such fine and prisonment ths

or by both such fine and im-prisonment. * Each separate day for any por-tion thereof during which any violation of this ordinance oc-curs or continues shall be deemed to construe a separate offense, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable as herein provided. Section 3. * The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of the foregoing ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Torrance Herald, a weekly newspaper printed, pub-lished and circulated in the City of Torrance and hereby designat-ed for that purpose, and there-upon and thereafter this or-dinance shall take effect thirty days affer the date of its adop-tion.
