Deer Season to Close Sept. 15 In Some Areas

With deer hunting in the Coastal counties closing Sept. 15, hunters in other sections of California today prepared for the opening of other districts from Sept. 15 to Oct. 15, inclusive.

2. The season is ending for Districts 2, 2½, 2¾, and 3, which comprises the coast counties from the coast range to the necesar, roughly from Mendocino county to Ventura.

Hunters shot down 25,000 deer last year and more deer tags have been sold this year than the 13,000 dissued in 1987. The limit is two deer per season, except in districts 15 and 4½, where only one is permitted.
