AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE REGULATING PARKING ON WATSON AND CARSON STREETS BETWEEN MANUEL AVENUE AND COTA AVENUE.

The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park, or permit to be parked, upon either side of Watson Street between Manuel Avenue and Carson Street, or upon either side of Carson Street between the southwest property line of Manuel Avenue and the east property line of Cota Avenue in the City of Torrance, any motor-vehicle whether attended or unattended during school hours.

Section 2: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days in the City Jail of the City of Torrance or by both such fine and imprisonment.
