Takes Three Calls To Get Firemen To Strip Blaze

It took three calls but finally a fire truck other than Torrance equipment responded to an alarm in the Shoestring strip last Friday.

As a grass fire threatened homes in the vicinity of 218th and Harvard avenue a call was put in to the central fire station here. Acting on legal advice that the Torrance department cannot go across a city boundary and remain protected by insurance, Director John Strohm of the Public Safety department, advised the residents to call the San Pedro fire department.

Their request finally reached the Harbor City semi-volunteer department and the equipment was taken out by William Myersenough and his son who found the grass blaze had spread to several eucalyptus trees. They halted it before the fire reached the threatened homes.

Efforts are being made by the city of Torrance to arrange a working agreement with the Los Angeles city territory contiguous to Torrance but so far the metropolitan department has not responded.

Fewer Families On Relief But More "Cases"

There are fewer families on indigent relief in Los Angeles today than at any time during 1938, despite the fact that there are more "cases," according to an analysis of charities department rolls made by Wayne Allen, chief administrative officer.

"Cause of the increase," Allen explained, "and the statement that there are more cases today, is because the county has accepted a largely-increased number of single men, now having 10,429 single cases, or men and women without dependents of any kind."

The total number of single cases has increased by 601 since the preliminary budget was adopted last August. Allen added: Total number of family cases on county relief rolls now is 6,167, as compared with 6,454 when the preliminary budget was adopted a decrease of 287 cases.

State relief rolls, on the other hand, have been reduced to 3,222 cases today, as compared with an average of 1,143 cases in June, 1938, Allen added.
