ORDINANCE NO. 369
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PLANNING COMMISSION; FIXING TERMS OF OFFICE OF MEMBERS; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 111.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Torrance, California, did on the 6th day of April, 1928, adopt its Ordinance No. 111 establishing a City Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the term of office of each member of the Planning Commission appointed under Ordinance No. 111 has expired.

NOW THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Torrance, California, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. That under and pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California known and referred to as "The Planning Act" of 1929, as amended, a Planning Commission in the City of Torrance, California, is hereby created and established, to consist of nine (9) members, six (6) members thereof to be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Torrance with the approval of the City Council, and three (3) ex-officio members, to-wit: The City Engineer of said City, or his designated deputy, and two (2) other ex-officio members, or their designated deputies or representatives, to be selected by the said City Council, one of whom may be a member of the City Council; and

Section 2. That upon the effective date of this ordinance the members of such Planning Commission shall be appointed for the following terms, to-wit:

Two (2) shall be appointed for the term of one (1) year;
Two (2) shall be appointed for the term of two (2) years;
One (1) shall be appointed for the term of three (3) years; and

One (1) shall be appointed for the term of four (4) years, from and after their appointment, respectively. Their successors, shall be appointed for terms of four years. Should a vacancy occur otherwise than by expiration of the respective term of office, it shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired portion of the term. The terms of the ex-officio members shall correspond to their respective official tenures.

Section 3. That said Planning Commission shall have and is hereby vested with all the powers and duties provided by said Act and such other powers and duties that may be conferred upon Planning Commissions by any and all laws of the State of California.

Section 4. That the Planning Commission now existing in the said City of Torrance, pursuant to said Ordinance No. 111, shall, after the effective date hereof, cease to exist, as well as all appointments made thereunder; and said Ordinance No. 111 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and set aside.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirty-first day from and after the date of its final passage.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and said ordinance shall be published once in the "Torrance Herald."
